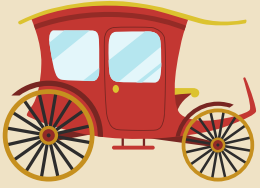


Experience New Hampshire's



Robert Frost - Old Stagecoach Byway



Morning

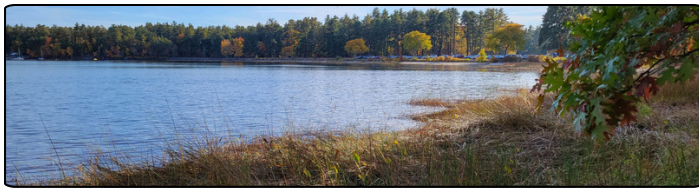
Begin your journey at the Old Stagecoach Byway's southern terminus, crossing the NH border and proceeding through **Atkinson** on Route 121. Pass beneath the leafy "Green Tunnel" and past Dow Commons and the Town Pound, built of stone 250+ years ago.

Hungry? Stop for a delicious down-home breakfast in **Hampstead**. Afterwards, admire Hampstead's historic Town Hall and even older Meeting House, whose belfry contains a bell cast by Paul Revere's son.

Proceed north into **Chester** and stretch your legs in the town's historic center, marveling at more 18th-century architecture. Consider patronizing local purveyors of gifts, knick-knacks, or crafts.

Stop in at NH Audubon's Massabesic Center in **Auburn**, open Tuesdays-Saturdays from 11-5. Kids or grandkids in tow? They'll love the animal room and nature shop, as well as the riveting trails enlivened with the sweet warbling of copious birds. Of course, peaceful lakeside vistas will appeal to all ages.

If you're not exhausted yet, consider a sojourn at the Robert Frost Farm, home to the great poet from 1900-1911 and byway namesake! For a nominal fee, take a tour of the house and feel free to explore the grounds and unique poetry trail, which transports the visitor directly into Frost's pastoral world.

But wait - the day's not quite over yet. Partake in a delightful **Derry** dinner before heading home. Options range from classic diner fare to the fine flavors of India, Italy, or China. Take a leisurely stroll downtown and maybe grab some ice cream - after a satisfying day on the byway, you deserve it!
